Terroir : Granite

Soil : Siliceous-clay

Varietal : Melon de Bourgogne 100%

Average vine age : 40 years

Yield : 35 Hl/Ha

Harvest : by hand

Ageing : underground tank with glass surface, 27 months

Bottling : January 26, 2017

Analysis before bottling :

- Alcohol content : 13%
- Total acidity (H₂SO₄) : 3,7 g/l
- Residual sugar : 2 g/l
- Free SO₂ : 33 mg/l

Food pairing : perfect with veal or refined cheese
